### **ORDER**

Whereas on considering the recommendations of the expert team of the Doctors and Public Health Specialists and based on the directive of Government of India, Ministry of Home Affairs, State-wide lockdown was extended from time to time and lastly extended till 24.00 hours of 31.03.2021 under the Disaster Management Act, 2005 in G.O.(Ms). No. 318, Revenue and Disaster Management Department, dated 28.02.2021.

2. In G.O fourth cited, all Higher Educational Institutions and Deemed Universities have been permitted to conduct online classes with effect from 23.03.2021 onwards with six working days.

3. The Director of Medical Education has opined that in view of the rising COVID cases and to prevent any occurrence of any clusters in Government and Government attached institutions and self-financing Deemed Universities running Medical and Paramedical courses in their Colleges and having hostels, as a precautionary and preventive measure, the students studying from first to the pre-final years studying various undergraduate courses namely MBBS/BDS/Pharmacy/Nursing/Paramedical Courses, the ongoing on campus classes can be conducted online until further orders.

4. In case of any ongoing examinations / practical examinations and those involving external examiners has already being scheduled and being conducted by any of these institutions those may be completed by

31.03.2021 without cancellation by strictly following the Corona appropriate behavior and Standard Operating Procedures. The Hostels for the Final Year students under all Under Graduate Courses / CRR I / Post Graduate Students would continue to function.

The Government after careful examination of the prevailing situation hereby directs that the Government and Government attached institutions and self-financing Deemed Universities running Medical and Paramedical courses in their Colleges and having hostels, as a precautionary and preventive measure, the students studying from first to the pre-final years, studying various undergraduate courses namely MBBS / BDS/ Pharmacy/Nursing/ Paramedical Courses, the ongoing on campus classes can be conducted online until further orders. In case of any ongoing examinations / practical examinations and those involving external examiners has already being scheduled and being conducted by any of these institutions those may be completed by 31.03.2021 without cancellation by strictly following the Corona appropriate behavior and Standard Operating Procedures. The Hostels for the Final Year students under all Under Graduate Courses / CRR I / Post Graduate Students would continue to function.
