ORDER:

In the Government Order first read above orders have been issued among others that all Private Colleges of nursing which do not have their own 150-bedded hospital should construct the same within a period of 3 years from the date of permission orders of the Government and till the completion of 3 years they may have tie-up arrangement with Government hospital for clinical training. It has also been ordered to grant tie up arrangement for further period of 2 years(i.e., for the period of 5 years) without insisting on own hospital, if any specific request is made by the Para Medical Schools / Colleges.

2. In the reference second read above, the President, Tamil Nadu Recognized Nursing Schools and Colleges Association, Karur has requested the Government to extend the time limit for another 5 years.

Government have examined the request of the President, the Tamil Nadu Recognized Nursing Schools and Colleges Association, Karur along with the amended statutes for affiliation of Nursing Colleges by the Tamil Nadu Dr. M.G.R. Medical University, Guindy, Chennai and have decided to accept it. Accordingly Government extend the time limit for another 5 years (as ordered in the Government Order first read above, for 5 years) without insisting on own hospital if any specific request is made by Para Medical Schools / Colleges for having tie up arrangement with Government Hospital / Government Head Quarters Hospital to undergo clinical training for their students studying in DGNM & B.Sc., (N) courses.

4. The Director of Medical Education, Director of Medical and Rural Health Services, are directed to take necessary action accordingly.
